2007 Art & Home Tour

In conjunction with the revitalization of the neighborhood surrounding Studio 1219, and to support artists from throughout the Blue Water Area, including Samia, as well as the entire State of Michigan, Studio 1219 will be hosting the Renaissance Roam 2007 Art & Home Tour.

The show will feature juried art which will have been chosen from artist submissions. This art will be displayed in "Home Galleries" in the Community Renaissance's Oakcrest Homes Development.

Trolleys will make round trips carrying patrons and participants from the Studio to between five and seven different homes, depending on availability at the time.

Each house will feature the art of one or more artists which will be selected by a jurying committee.

Friday night's event will include music in each home and a wine & cheese reception at the Studio. Art will be for sale at all home galleries and Studio 1219.

Saturday will be free and open to all ages. (No trolley service available Sat.)

The Application Process:

- Applications should be accompanied with five examples of your work on CD (JPEG/PDF format) or 4 X 6 photographs.
- Applications should include a short bio including shows you have participated in and your artist's statement.
- Applications must be received by 6:00 p.m. on April 12, 2007.
- Please include a self-addressed, stamped mailer if you want your CD or photos returned, or make arrangements with the gallery director to pick them up.
- Application fee of \$25.00 for Artist Network members, or \$35.00 for non-members.
- Chosen artists participating in the show will be guaranteed a minimum \$200 stipend from the event sales or 75% commission will be paid to the artist, whichever is greater.

The Criteria for Selection:

- Work should have a fresh or unusual individual style.
- Work should show command of the medium and warrant a closer look.
- Work should display technical

excellence and evidence of creative exploration.

- Creative use of materials and/or a novel approach.
- Variety within the medium---work should not have a mass produced or commercial feel.
- Number of pieces accepted from each artist will be determined by availability of space at the time of the show.
- **To ensure quality and originality, work will not be accepted that is:**
 - (a) A copy of the work of others;
 - (b) Made entirely from a kit or commercial design; and/or
 - (c) An article made entirely from a commercial mold.

The Jurying Process:

- A credible jury will review your application and portfolio with the criteria in mind. The jury committee will decide on an appropriate variety of work for this show that will also be compatible with individual homes. All decisions of the committee are final. You will be notified in writing as to acceptance or rejection of your application.

If You Are Selected:

- You will be contacted by the Gallery Director as to location drop-off of your art by mid-April.
- For the protection of both the art and the studio, the artist will be expected to hang work for the

show with the assistance of Studio 1219 Gallery Director David Stoneberg.

- The Committee will take the utmost care in handling the work but cannot be responsible for loss or damage. Artist must sign a release form.
 - All pieces must be dry and ready to be displayed. All unframed art work needs a hanging sleeve or loops on the back. All edges should be finished.
- Artists or a representative must be available to answer questions about their work and to participate in the festivities both days of the event.
